

Lab Gas Technician UL4001

Job Overview:

Ensure all customers have adequate supply of Liquid Nitrogen and Compressed Gas Cylinders. Deliver, fill (if necessary), order, and dispose of cylinders per established Standard Operating Procedures and in accordance with all Sodexo policies and procedures. Serve as the contact person between Sodexo, Client, and vendors.

General Responsibilities:

Support Scientists in GXP/NON-GXP labs:

- Pick up and deliver liquid nitrogen dewars, packaged gases, and related articles.
- Fill liquid nitrogen dewars, using the bulk liquid nitrogen filling stations following procedural steps and safety rules during filling and transport.
- Monitor and record levels and pressures of the bulk liquid nitrogen, bulk liquid carbon dioxide, micro-bulk liquid nitrogen, and micro-bulk liquid oxygen systems.
- Take appropriate action when deficiencies are noted.
- File and maintain delivery documentation.
- Routinely check inventory of compressed gas cylinders and place orders for customers as needed.
- Maintain housekeeping and inventory levels of liquid nitrogen bulk filling areas and packaged gas storage areas.
- Follow all procedures in performing all aspects of handling pressurized and cryogenic tanks.
- Communicate and coordinate maintenance and service work for equipment.
- Serve as the liaison for scientists for gas-related issues.
- Troubleshoot any issues and submit work orders as needed.
- Participate in audits and inspections and provide input as requested.
- Submit weekly metric information to management and raise concerns or issues.
- Participate in rotational on call schedule.
- Continuous Improvement: Seek to continuously raise standards and improve quality of performance and service. Comply with all company and statutory regulations relating to safe systems of work, health, and safety. This will include awareness of any specific hazards in the workplace. All documentation up to date and correct.

EHS, Safety, Compliance

- Adhere to Quality, Compliance, and Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) standards.
- Report near misses and participate in Sodexo Safety programs.
- Ensure correct Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is used at all times.
